If you have any medical or coronary history that may be aggravated by this course, you should consult your physician and ask his/her advice as to whether you should participate in a CPR course.

If you have any reservations about being able to perform CPR on a cardiac arrest victim, you should consider this before beginning this course.

If you have recently had any infectious disease, including upper respiratory infection or open sores on your mouth or on hands, it is imperative to defer mannequin practice until you are well.
