This is the daily press release from Valley City Hall, with news from the city and other important announcements:

- The Public Works Division has been transferred from Valley City Hall to the former Mid-South complex located at 5220 Fairfax Bypass. Director John McConnell and his entire work staff are now based out of this building, which is open 8-5, Monday through Friday, and staffed with a departmental clerk who will be glad to answer your telephone calls, or accept applications for commercial burning. Trash payments may still be made at Valley City Hall; however, residents are encouraged to utilize the automatic withdrawal program, whereas your monthly solid waste bill is automatically deducted from your checking or savings account. A night drop box remains at the main entrance of Valley City Hall for overnight and weekend payments.
- A major drainage repair project is underway on Wellington Street in the Fairfax community, following two drain basins collapsing following recent heavy rainfall. Motorists are asked to exercise caution while driving in this area near the Cub Scout House and Fairfax Elementary School. Repairs are ongoing, with project completion anticipated within two weeks, weather permitting. The city apologizes for any inconvenience this work may cause.
- The Valley City Council will meet in regular session on Monday, January 22nd beginning at 7:00 pm Eastern Time. Employee service certificates will be given at the meeting, and a work session will follow.
- The City of Valley has partnered with Goodwill Industries, allowing a donated goods collection box to be placed at the Langdale Mill parking area, near 59th Street. The box is emptied daily, and residents are invited to deposit their donated items at this site, 24 hours a day.
