Athletic Field Maintenance Manager

We have an opening for a full-time Athletic Field Maintenance Manager for the Parks and Recreation department.

Under general supervision, the Athletic Field Maintenance Manager will be responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the Sportsplex fields and surrounding areas. This position will develop, implement, and coordinate short and long-range plans pertaining to the athletic fields and turf maintenance program to include all aspects of irrigation and irrigation systems, weed control, fertilization, turf development, turf repair, turf renovation, grass cutting, cutting procedures, soil testing, field drainage, landscaping, infield preparation, and construction for the City's athletic fields. This position will maintain the vegetation beds in the City of Valley, maintain grass areas around Recreation Department facilities and rental properties, and line fields for the City's recreation programs, local high school programs, and local college programs.

This position will report the Assistant Director - Athletics.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Associates degree in Agronomy, Turf Grass Management, or a related field and three to five years of lead or supervisory experience
- Certifications in Oriental and Turf Pest Control Commercial Application and Setting of Landscape Plants

Environmental Hazards and Physical Requirements:

- This job may risk exposure to extreme heat and cold, wet or humid conditions, dust and pollen, noise, electrical shock, odors, and moving machinery.
- Requires medium to heavy workload that involves walking, standing, stooping, lifting and exerting between 20 and 50 pounds of force on a regular and recurring basis.
- Will require some weekend work
- Must have a valid driver's license
